

Student Advisory Board

The Student Advisory Board of the Nonprofit & Public Management (NPM) Center provides an opportunity for graduate students in the Schools of Business, Public Policy, and Social Work to be involved with the direction of NPM's student services. Comprised of four to six students from each school, these students provide input and assistance to a number of activities, which include:

- Counseling and assisting NPM staff with programs, services and other activities to further NPM's mission
- Identifying future programs to enhance the educational experience of students interested in nonprofit sector involvement
- Planning and promoting major events with high-profile speakers in areas such as philanthropy, social entrepreneurship, and nonprofit leadership
- Planning and promoting informal events, which include brown bag presentations, workshops, and career development panels of leading practitioners in nonprofit management
- Recruiting and mobilizing students interested in being involved with NPM's activities
- Providing recommendations on how NPM can engage with faculty and influence curriculum

Expectations of Members

Student Advisory Board members typically volunteer four to six hours per month, which includes a 1.5 hour long monthly board meeting, serving on one to two committees, coordinating events and workshops, and serving as a liaison to students.

To apply, email your resume and personal statement to nonprofit@umich.edu. Your personal statement should include the following:

- Why you are interested in serving on NPM's Student Advisory Board as a representative of your school
- A description of your nonprofit and public management interests
- An explanation of your relevant experiences and what you would bring to the board
